| PROGRAM OBJECTIVE: | | | |
| <p>This course is designed to introduce the student to the science of Cosmetology through theoretical and practical application designed to instill good work habits, ethics, good grooming, and professionalism. Skills related to the field of Cosmetology are introduced, fine-tuned, and polished as it pertains to all pertinent aspects of hair care, nail care, and skin care. The curriculum for this course is developed to prepare students for the Florida State Written and Practical Cosmetology Examination for Licensure.</p> | | | |

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION:

Classes are taught on a full-time or part-time basis, five or three days a week schedule. Theory classes are conducted every day, along with practical application each day. Classes are taught by lecture, demonstration, audio visual aids, and live "hands on" participation by all students. Some of the teaching methods used are question and answers, note taking, role playing, discussions and project assignments, and special guest presentations.

Upon successful completion, a completed application for Cosmetology Initial Examination shall be submitted to the Florida Department of Business and Professional Regulation, Division of Professions, Board of Cosmetology along with the applicable fees. Once the exam has been passed, the graduate will be duly licensed to practice in the State of Florida. Students will complete this program in 30-63 weeks, based on a full-time or part-time schedule at 19 hours to 35 hours weekly.
